DIRECT SERVICES – CITIZENSHIP, LEGAL AID, KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

OCCORD – Citizenship / Immigrant Rights

Free citizenship application support & classes, Know Your Rights workshops, and Family Preparedness Planning.

OC Justice Fund – Bond Funding/ Know Your Rights

Provides bond funds and Know Your Rights workshops to support immigrant communities facing detention and deportation.

Hosts Know Your Rights workshops and youth-centered organizing spaces for immigrant empowerment.

DIRECT SERVICES – COMMUNITY SUPPORT, RAPID RESPONSE, WELLNESS

OCRRN (OC Rapid Response Network) – ICE Alerts / Verified Security Reports

Real-time alerts about ICE activity and rapid response support for impacted individuals.

Delhi Neighborhood – Community Support Services

Offers ride services (drop-off/pick-up), grocery assistance, and accompaniment to bus stops and appointments.

BAJI (Black Alliance for Just Immigration – LA) – Translation & Immigrant Advocacy

Supports African, Caribbean, and Black immigrant communities with translation and advocacy support not widely offered elsewhere.
